School Values


Excellence

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. The nominee is a Singaporean citizen.
- 2. The nominee is a role model in his/her conduct (attitude, behaviours and actions). His/Her conduct grades are "Very Good" or "Excellent".
- 3. The nominee has demonstrated good character in a consistent manner.





Eligibility Criteria

4. The nominee has demonstrated the school values (Innovation, Excellence, Respect, Responsibility, Resilience).
